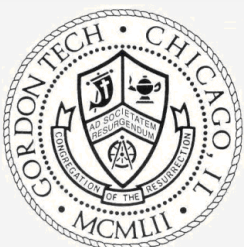

The Rams plan to use this momentum as they enter the Chicago Catholic League Tournament.

The Girls' Varsity basketball team has continued their hot streak, defeating two key opponents. On Monday, January 9th, the Lady Rams defeated Mt. Assisi 54-48. Gordon Tech scored 10 unanswered points in the final minutes to secure the victory over conference rival Mt. Assisi. This is the first time the Rams had beaten the Eagles in six years. Leading the charge were Murielle Vansach (Oliver McCracken) with 16 points and another

double-double by Melanie Claudio (St. Ladislaus) with 10 points and 10 rebounds.
